The Department of Surgery has experienced strong growth since 2010. The department's core teaching faculty currently consists of 15 fulltime faculty, 10 part-time faculty and numerous voluntary faculty who provide case volume and educational experiences. TBHC has the latest technology including the state-of-the-art daVinci XI robot, an advanced surgical robot system, and a multimillion dollar simulation facility, where residents receive training in laparoscopy, intubation, central line placement and code simulations.
